

TUNNEL TRAP

The KBL Tunnel Trap has been designed to attract and kill ferrets, stoats and weasels. Erazz non toxic rabbit lure proven to be effective in attracting mustelids to cage or kill traps should be used. It stays palatable and fresh smelling for much longer (4-6 weeks) than fresh baits that need renewing after a matter of days. Ensure the bait is secure on the trigger and if using Erazz paste, place a good dollop (2 to 3 tablespoons) of Erazz into a piece of muslin cloth or similar and attach onto the trigger with fuse wire.



Trap Placement

- Along bush/pasture margins, roads and tracks, ridges, streams, water courses, tracks and roadways.
- When targeting animals over large areas: traps set to control ferrets should be spaced at 200 metre intervals and for stoats/weasels between 100 and 200 metres.
- When mustelids are being controlled around waterway or ponds, or in a small forest block the distance between traps will need to be reduced to 50 metres or place traps around individual nests to ensure adequate protection of the species being protected.

To bait and set the trap

- Turn the trap upside down and push the bait onto the trigger wire as far as the bend.
- Place the trap the right way up and peg the trap to the ground through the holes on either side of the base rim.
- Hold the trap firmly with one hand and pull the nylon cord with the other hand until you feel the striker bar come down into the set position.

To remove the dead animal

- Remove the pegs from the base and turn the trap over.
- Pull the nylon cord in the same manner as for setting the trap, until you can free the dead animal. Take care not to reset the trap at this stage.
- The trap should be baited again with Erazz, turned the right way over, and reset for another time.
