

Rodent Control - Rat Bait Box

A robust and long life bait station suitable for housing many different types of rodent baits.



Uses

The rat bait box is used by professional animal controllers, farmers and food processing plant staff to secure rodent baits in a safe way in outdoor and indoor areas.

Why the Rat bait Box?

- Protects bait from the weather, prevents non targets from eating baits, and prevents rodents from translocating baits.
- Rodents can feed inside the bait box without the fear of being discovered. This will ensure an adequate poison strike.
- The roomy size of the station allows multiple feedings by rats at the same time bringing populations under control quickly.
- The protruding tunnel entrance ways help to preclude non target species from reaching in to access baits or in gaining entry into the station.
- Child and pet resistant lid closure.
- Metal rod inside the compartment for suspending solid bait and also suitable for placements of RatAbate® Paste.
- The Bait Box has been designed to sit against a wall to take advantage of the typical hunting characteristics of the rat.
- Especially suitable for rural situations where high rodent numbers can prevail and a lot of bait is needed to be placed in a safe manner.
